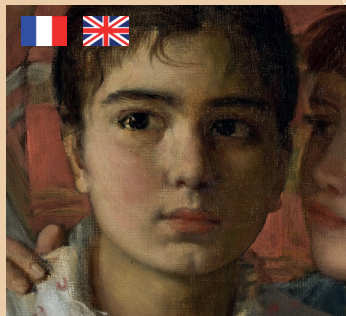
Museums of Limouxin

Museum of Fine Arts – Musée Petiet - Limoux

In the former painting studio of the Petiet family, the museum invites you to discover two centuries of painting. Canvas by Marie Petiet and Achille Laugé (pointillist), Etienne Dujardin Beaumetz. Digital work installed in the Museum and readable from the interactive book. Recreational visit for children. Cycles of lectures, concerts and creative workshops.

Printing Museum - Limoux

Piano Museum - Limoux

In a desacralized church, a collection of two centuries of Pianos : Pleyel, Erard, Elcé and models unique in the world. The majority of exhibits were donated to European France. An auditorium has been arranged in the choir of the church, and hosts concerts of classical music.

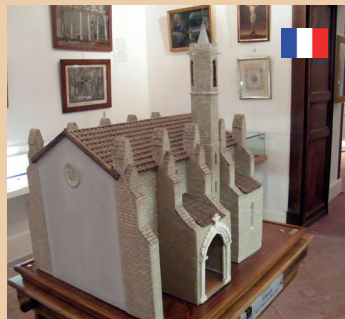
Museum of Automata - Limoux

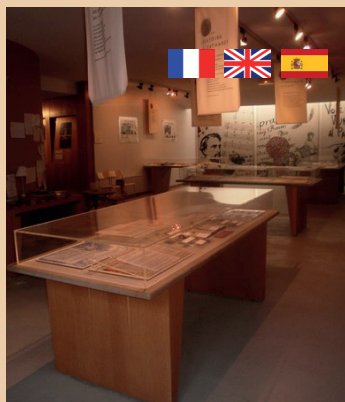


Museum of Ex-voto - Limoux

Musée Déodat Roché - Arques

At the heart of the village, the birthplace of Déodat Roché (1877-1978), historian and philosopher of Catharism, houses a permanent exhibition dedicated to Catharism, approached by four doors and the personal effects of his life in the village, letters, clothes, office ... Spiritual, political and a final approach to the daily life of the Cathars. On the first floor, we discover various temporary exhibitions.
