Built at the beginning of the 20th century to commemorate Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face, the Basilica was consecrated in 1954. Covering an area of 4,500m² with a 95m high dome, it is one of the largest churches built during the 20th century. Its dimensions and interior design impress visitors from all over the world. The second most important sanctuary in France after Lourdes, the Basilica of Sainte-Thérèse is a must when it comes to places of pilgrimage in Lisieux! The relics of Saint Theresa and her parents, Saints Louis and Zélie Martin, are found here.

Orbec Mushroom Farm is one of the last in Normandy that cultivates its mushrooms in a natural cellar. Situated on the border between the two towns of Orbec and La Vespière, this natural cellar certainly sheltered the first inhabitants of Orbec. Exploited as a quarry from the Middle Ages until the beginning of the 20th century, the chalk extracted from the site now distinguishes some beautiful mansions in Orbec built with this material. The transformation of the mushroom growing site dates back to the 1930s and continues to this day. Operations were even maintained at a low level when the site was used as a refuge for civilians after the Allied landings in the summer of 1944. Occupied in the evenings and then nights and days on the eve of the liberation of the city by the Canadians at the end of August 1944, the mushroom farm welcomed up to 2127 people within its walls. Today it is a small family business that happily makes use of this 6,000m2 site to produce oyster mushrooms, button mushrooms and shiitake mushrooms. The visit will allow you to discover how to cultivate these 3 mushrooms but also a natural space shaped by man and which is part of the local history.



THE LISIEUX OF YESTERDAY AND THE LISIEUX **OF TODAY**

UA tour guide will take you through the streets of the city to discover its history and heritage: the Gallo-Roman city, the bishop's palace and its garden, the cathedral, the canonical houses and mansions, and finally the city of the Fifties. From the ancient city to the contemporary city, you will understand why Lisieux is an exceptional city.

ART DECO

After the First World War, Lisieux, like many towns in France, resumed its urban development. It is the beginning of the Roaring Twenties. More and more pilgrims are arriving here to pray to St. Thérèse. There are new buildings on the streets near the station and convent. While the facades of religious souvenir shops are adorned with carved Gothic decorations, companies and hotels opt for a more modern layout comprising of decorative arts. Come and observe these contrasts of the Roaring Twenties, between ostentatious modernity and references to an idealised past.

LIVAROT-PAYS D'AUGE _

CITÉ FROMAGÈRE (CHEESE CITY)

Livarot, which has been a metallurgical town since the Middle Ages became the market place for the cheese that would bear its name, from the 17th century onwards. There are also rooms built especially for the maturing of the cheeses. In 1910, the Georges Bisson cheese dairy was set up at the gates of the town next to Mr Georges Leroy's new cheese box factory. The two factories thus became the engines of the city and set the rhythm of town life until the 1960s. Discover the history and heritage of Cheese town!

BRICK COLOUR

It symbolises the wealth of the milk and cheese makers of our countryside who made their fortune by selling their cheeses on the Parisian markets. 
FERVAQUES

Known for its early 17th century castle and its famous occupants, Madame de Custine and Châteaubriand, the village of Fervaques was one of Eugène Boudin's favourite haunts during his visits to his patron, Doctor Jacquette. The artist liked to paint there on the banks of the Touques river. Discover Fervaques through his work along a route through the town centre.
