

# Calling all adrenaline-seekers: the Mont4 Zipline awaits!



The Mont Fort zipline has been a runaway success since it opened in August 2020.

Numerous people have already launched themselves upon this aerial adventure along a line that connects the top of Mont Fort with the Col des Gentianes.

This winter, this zipline will open (weather permitting) as soon as the Mont Fort sector does, which is sche-

duled for 12 December. With speeds of up to 130 km an hour, a 1,400 metre-long course and a 383 metre altitude drop, the stats will definitely get you in a spin! So, are you ready to throw yourself into the void?

# Montgenèvre: a new partner resort in the southern French Alps

The 4 Vallées has signed a new partner resort agreement with the French ski resort of Montgenèvre.

If you have an annual pass and thus are eligible for various e-vouchers and digital coupons, you can now enjoy 5 days' skiing in this new partner resort – absolutely free! Seen as the 'grand old lady' of French ski resorts, Montgenèvre opened in 1907. Its first ski-lift was installed in 1936. It's a really family-friendly resort which boasts 50,000 m<sup>2</sup> of nursery slopes. However, hardened skiers aren't left out either, with around 50 red and black pistes, enabling them to have some very physically-demanding fun. Montgenèvre consists of two ski areas: Grand Montgenèvre, with 95km of pistes and 24 ski lifts, and Monts la Lune, boasting 110km of runs and 31 lifts. It's possible to ski between these areas. The latter ski area is linked with the Italian 'Milky Way' (Via Lattea) ski area, with 400km worth of runs.

If you'd like to stay on a bit longer, or explore the 400km of runs offered by the Via Lattea (which includes the resorts of Montgenèvre, Sestrières and Sauze d'Oulx), you can buy a day ski pass in these resorts for around  $50 \in$ .



# Completion of the snow-making project in the Savoleyres sector

Summer 2020 saw the completion of the snow-making project in the Savoleyres – La Tzoumaz sector, as laid out in Téléverbier's PAD-PAZ (urban planning masterplan). Work on the 4-year project began in 2017 and has enabled the lower Cœur run to benefit from artificial snow cover. This section thus provides an alternative to descending the Etablons run and gives you access to La Tzoumaz by ski even at the start of the season, when snow has not yet fallen in the lower altitude parts of the resort.

## Changes to the Chassoure gondola lift

All skiers who love Verbier will be familiar with the gondola lift system between Tortin and Chassoure, as well as the run above which it travels, the famous 'mur de Tortin' (an extremely steep run). This ski lift is very popular in winter and is now going to see its hourly capacity increased from 1,400 to 1,600 people thanks to the addition of six new cabins. Its electrical drive has also been replaced as part of the renewal of the contract to operate the line. This change will reduce energy consumption, which is all part of Téléverbier's long-term strategy to reduce its environmental footprint through initiatives coming under the 'la Montagne Verte' (the Green Mountain) umbrella.

# The Grand-Tsai to Bruson ski tow has had a makeover

As it no longer met current norms, the Grand-Tsai to Bruson ski tow, built in 1976, was replaced during the summer of 2020 by a brand-new Garaventa tow. Costing around 1,200,000 Swiss Francs, this ski tow has greater capacity compared to the old system and can whisk a little over 700 people up the slopes every hour. Its route has been slightly modified to finish directly at the top of the 'Grand-Tsai', meaning that skiers now have very easy access to the slopes in the Val de Bagnes.

A new run has been created to avoid the ski tow route. The descent to Orsières now runs parallel and entirely to the south of the ski tow.

# Téléverbier adds three new snow groomers to its fleet

The company is continuing to make new investments. This year, it ordered three snow groomers from Prinoth (the Leitwolf model). These snow groomers are branded with the Verbier 4Vallées logo. The total cost of this purchase was about 1,300,000 Swiss Francs.



# Places where there's fun for everyone!

In the Verbier sector (specifically, La Chaux) freestylers can really have a field day at the Snowpark, which is open until the end of April. Enjoy yourself on the park's numerous features (kickers, rails, boxes, ramps for big air moves, mini half-pipes...) not forgetting a big air bag (inflatable landing zone) that's ideal for learning tricks. This terrain park is suitable for all levels of expertise and is groomed every day for your safety.

Near this snowpark is the Audi Skicross Park and a mini speed skiing course where you can take on your friends. The Audi quattro funslope in La Tzoumaz is great for kids who want to learn the basics of freestyle skiing and snowboarding whilst having fun on a run that's punctuated with obstacles and features.

It's on the Taillay run, more than 2,226 metres above sea level, that snow-lovers can embark on this 400 metre-long course, which includes a 10 metre-long fun twister and a 15 metre curved wall-ride.

The 23 other features (banked turns, jumps, an aboveground tunnel...) all add up to a really adrenaline-pumping experience.



# Verbier Express: a direct train service between Geneva and Verbier

Would you love to have an easy way of getting to the slopes without having to undergo a long, tiring drive? If the answer to that is yes, then the Verbier Express is for you!

This service was launched during the 2019-2020 winter season. It proved extremely popular and will therefore run again this year. The Verbier Express enables you to travel to Le Châble from Geneva without changing in Martigny. It runs on Saturdays, Sundays and some public holidays during winter.

There are multiple advantages to choosing the train: it's an easy way of getting to the slopes, you can benefit from discounts of up to 70% off your journey, not to mention a discount on a one-day ski pass. You're also doing your bit for the planet!

Same-day returns are available, from Le Châble to Geneva (the journey includes intermediate stops).


