

## New COVID-19 measures effective as of 18.01.21

Following the new protection measures put in place on January 13th by the Swiss Federal Council in order to fight against the progression of COVID-19, you will find below details of the open and closed infrastructures in our destination:

Books and Games Libraries Access to reading rooms not allowed Mandatory mask	Cultural sites such as cinema, museums and reading rooms of library
